

CARE OF YOUR WOODEN GARDEN SCULPTURE

- Treat the sculpture every 6 months by liberally applying a clear, spirit based, wood preservative such as *Wickes* 'Clear Wood Preserver' paying a lot of attention to the base.
- When dry (after three days), finish with a couple of coats of Teak Oil or Danish Oil. This will enhance the grain and colour of the wood as well as slowing down the drying process and reducing cracking of the wood.
- Keep the sculpture aerated in your garden by keeping the base off the ground on small loose pebbles.
- Do not store the sculpture indoors as the green wood will quickly crack.
